
SHCS rule for plasma sampling

Rule

ONE plasma sample per year composed of **FIVE aliquots** (≥0.5 mL) should be taken (max +/- 30 days from follow-up visit) [figure 1].



Exceptions

Registration

At registration and at the **following 4 follow-up** visits, **FIVE** aliquots should be taken [figure 2 and 3].

Viral load >400 cps/mL

- When a **VL >400 cps/mL** was detected, **4 follow-ups** have to be sampled (virological failure or treatment naive) [figure 4 and 5].
- Always the last follow-up with a VL >400 cps/mL has to be considered [figure 6].
- If there was no follow-up visit at the date of VL >400 cps/mL or no sampling was performed within the allowed 30 days, **the whole follow-up visit has to be repeated at the next visit** (complete cohort visit (!), no penalties are given for too close follow-up visits in this case (<120 days) [figure 7]).
